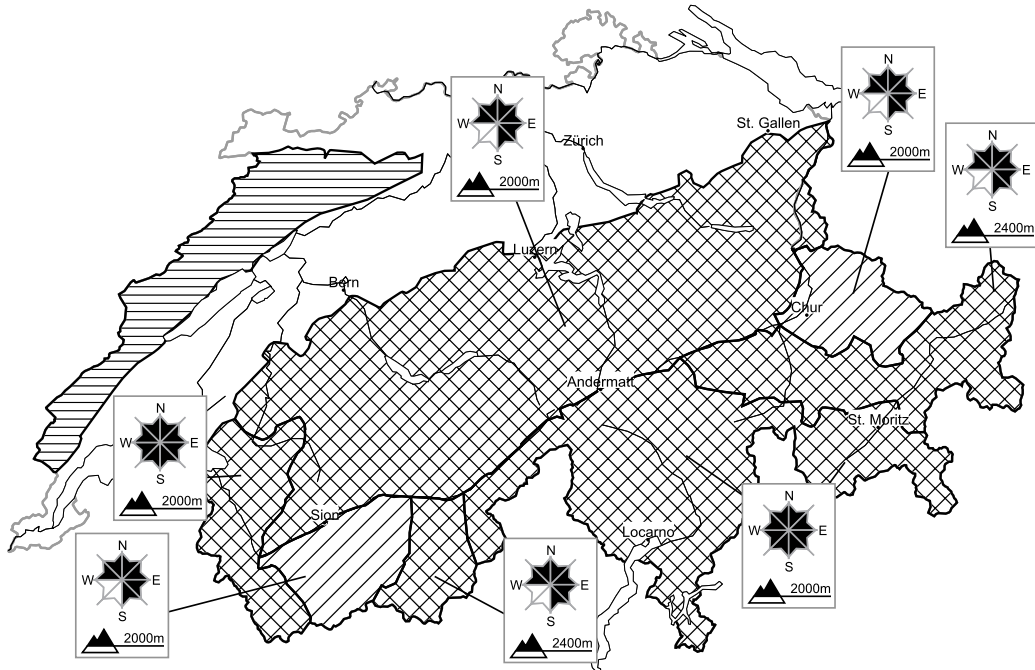


Considerable avalanche danger will be encountered over a wide area

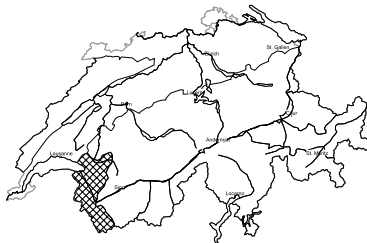

Avalanche danger



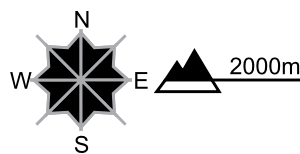
region A

Avalanche prone locations



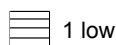
Danger description

As a consequence of fresh snow and wind extensive snow drift accumulations have formed. Somewhat older snow drift accumulations are in some cases still prone to triggering. These avalanche prone locations are covered with fresh snow and barely recognisable. Avalanches can be released, even by a single winter sport participant and reach medium size. Individual natural avalanches are possible. Backcountry touring calls for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger and caution.

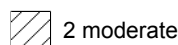
Full-depth avalanches, Wet avalanches as day progresses

On steep east, south and west facing slopes full-depth and wet avalanches are to be expected below approximately 2400 m. These can reach medium size.

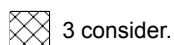
Danger levels



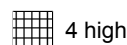

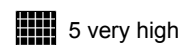
