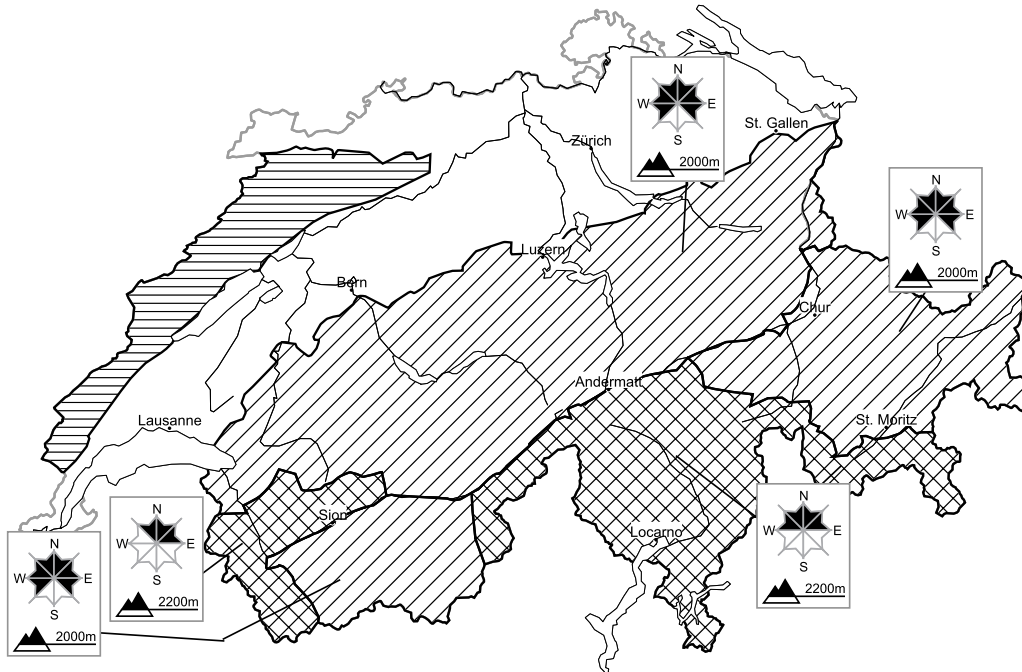


# Increase in danger of wet and full-depth avalanches as the day progresses

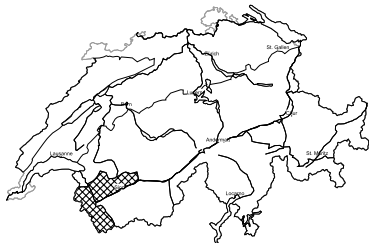

## Dry avalanches



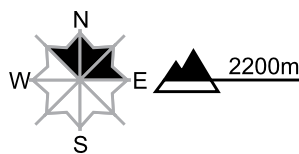
### Dry, region A

#### Danger description

The fresh and somewhat older snow drift accumulations are in some cases still prone to triggering. Avalanches can in some places be released by a single winter sport participant. These can in isolated cases reach medium size. Backcountry touring calls for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger and careful route selection.
