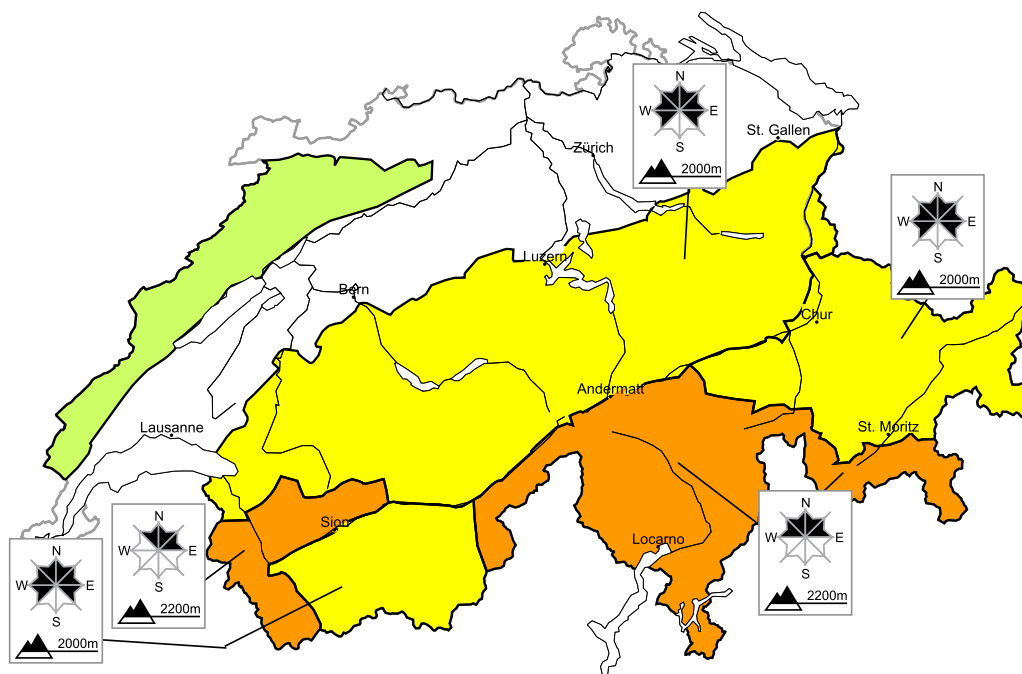


Increase in danger of wet and full-depth avalanches as the day progresses

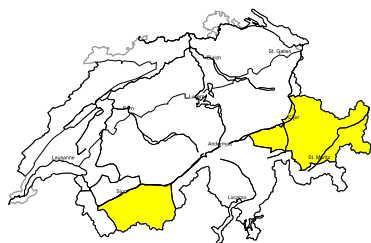

Dry avalanches



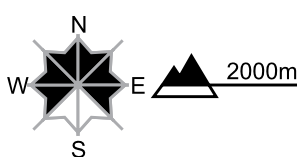
Dry, region D

Danger description

The fresh and somewhat older snow drift accumulations are in some cases still prone to triggering. Avalanches can additionally in isolated cases be released in deeper layers. This applies in particular on very steep north facing slopes in little used backcountry terrain. Mostly avalanches are small. Backcountry touring calls for careful route selection.

Additional danger: Wet avalanches as day progresses (see 2nd map)

3 consider.

4 high

5 very high
