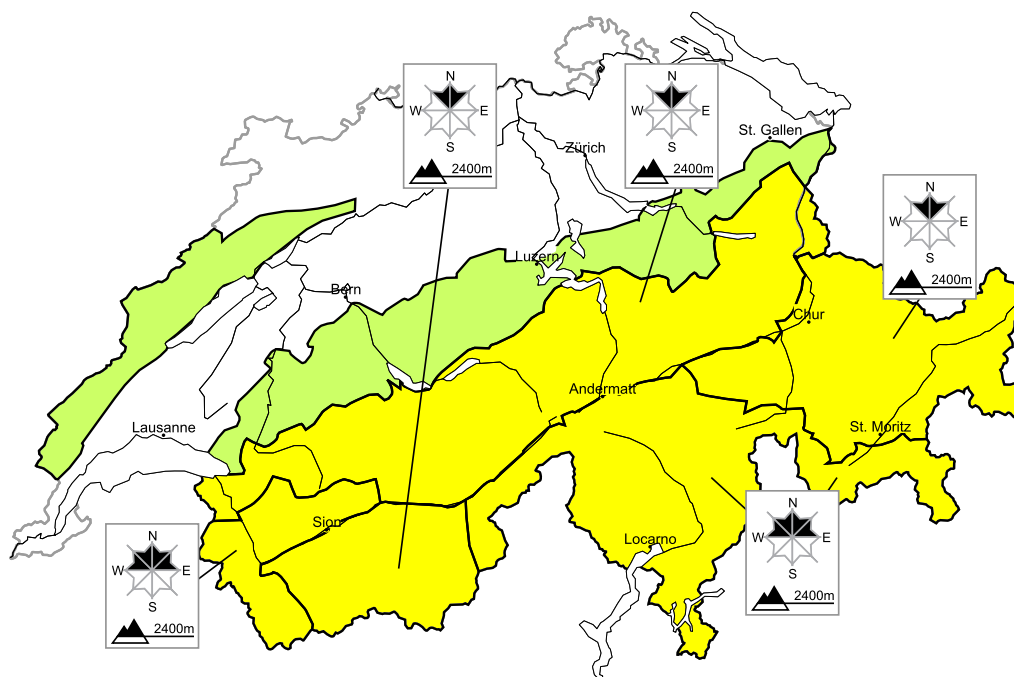


Increase in danger of wet and full-depth avalanches as the day progresses

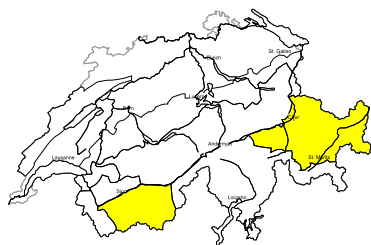

Dry avalanches



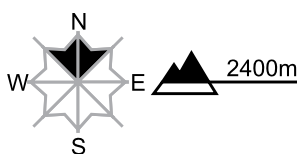
Dry, region C

Danger description

Older snow drift accumulations are in some cases still prone to triggering. Avalanches can additionally in isolated cases be released in deeper layers. Apart from the danger of being buried, restraint should be exercised also in view of the danger of avalanches sweeping people along and giving rise to falls. Backcountry touring calls for careful route selection.

Additional danger: Wet avalanches as day progresses (see 2nd map)

2 moderate

3 consider.

4 high

5 very high
