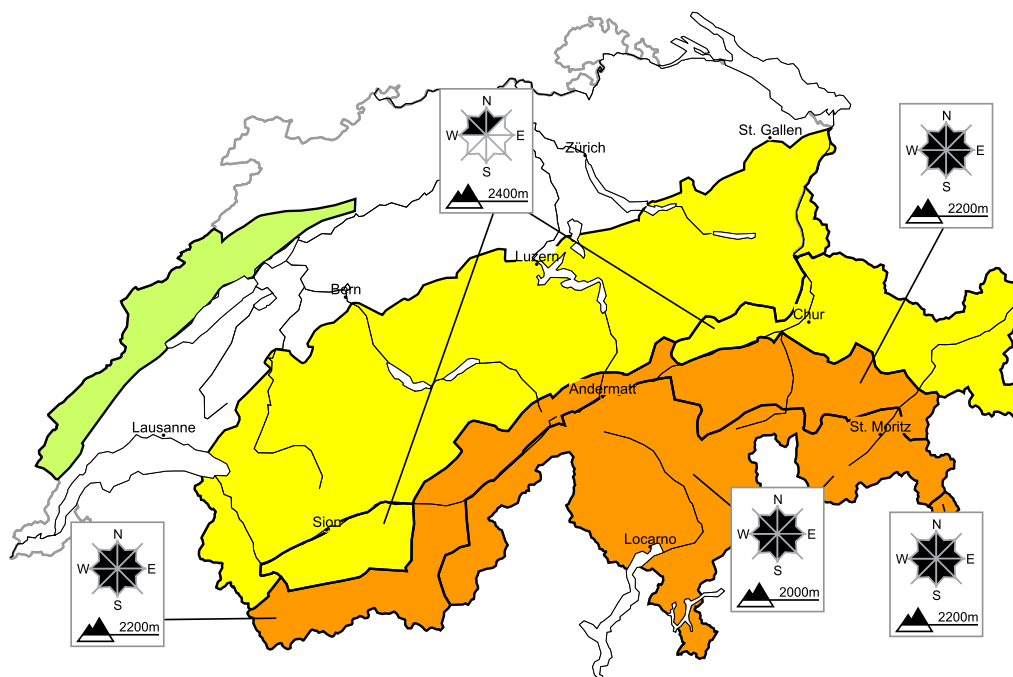


# Outside marked and open pistes a critical avalanche situation will be encountered in some regions

## Avalanche danger



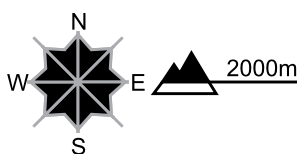
region A

#### Danger description

Avalanches can over a wide area be released, even by a single winter sport participant. Individual natural avalanches are possible. In particular on steep north facing slopes avalanches can in some cases reach large size. Exposed parts of transportation routes are endangered in very few cases now. The backcountry touring conditions remain critical.

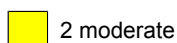
### Wet and full-depth avalanches

As a consequence of solar radiation moist snow slides and avalanches are possible below approximately 2400 m. Full depth avalanches can reach dangerously large size. Areas with glide cracks are to be avoided.

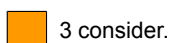
Danger levels



1 low



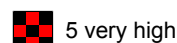
2 moderate
