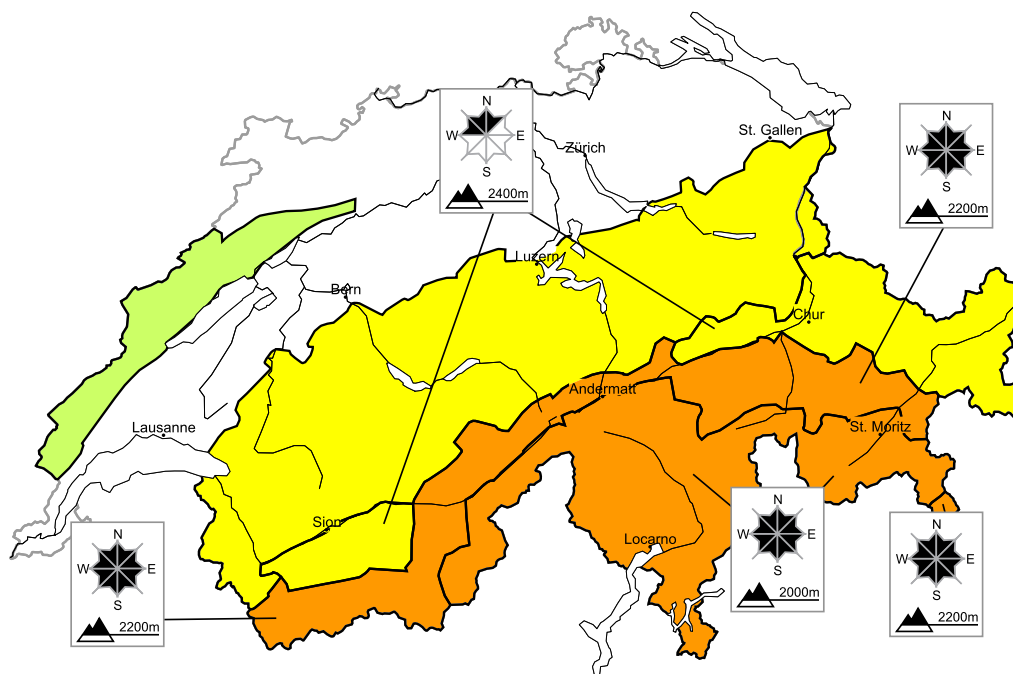


Outside marked and open pistes a critical avalanche situation will be encountered in some regions

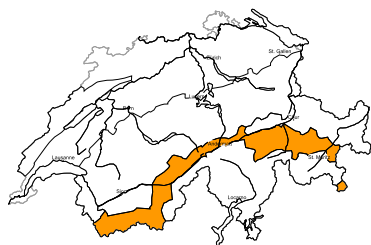

Avalanche danger



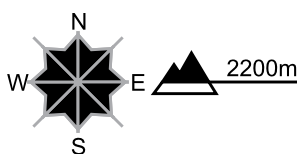
region B

Danger description

Fresh snow and snow drift accumulations can be released, even by a single winter sport participant and reach dangerously large size. Avalanches can additionally in some places be released in deeper layers, especially on steep north facing slopes.

Experience in the assessment of avalanche danger is recommended.

Wet and full-depth avalanches

As a consequence of solar radiation moist and west avalanches are possible below approximately 2400 m. Full depth avalanches can reach dangerously large size. Areas with glide cracks are to be avoided.

Danger levels

1 low

2 moderate

3 consider.

4 high

5 very high
