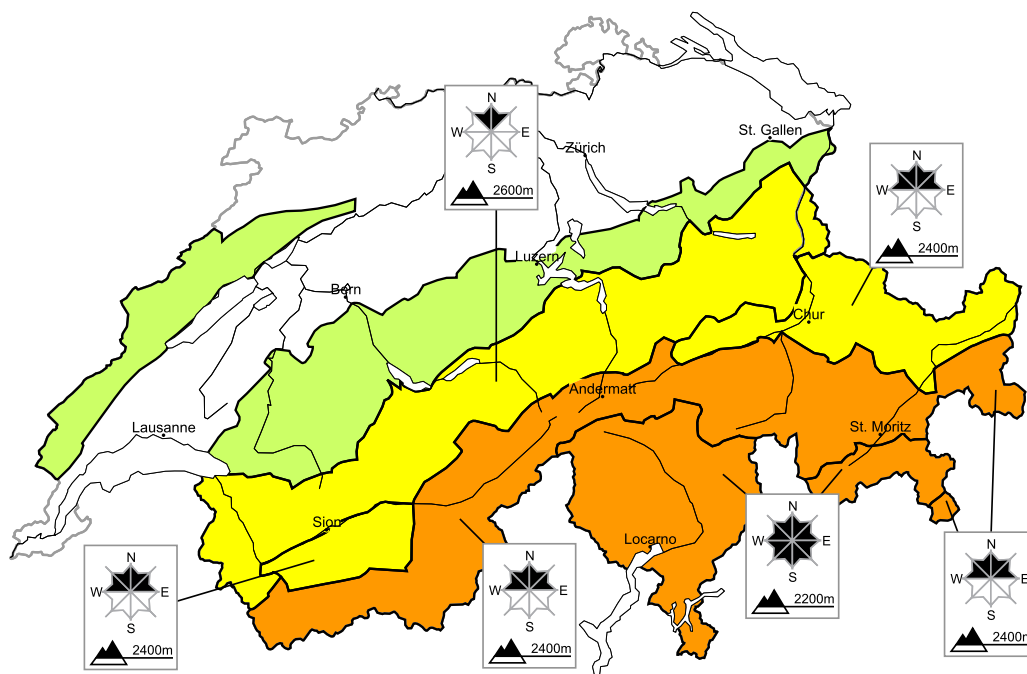


# Outside marked and open pistes a considerable avalanche danger will be encountered in some regions

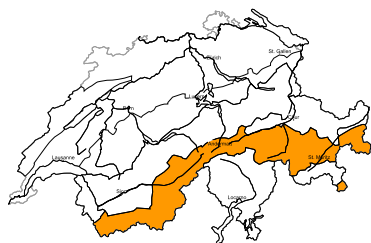

## Dry avalanches



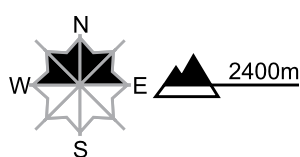
### Dry, region B

#### Danger description

The snow drift accumulations of the last few days can be released by a single winter sport participant. Avalanches can in isolated cases be released in deeper layers also, especially on steep north facing slopes. Avalanches can reach medium size. Backcountry touring and other off-piste activities call for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger.

**Additional danger: Wet avalanches as day progresses (see 2nd map)**

Danger levels

1 low

2 moderate

3 consider.

4 high

5 very high
