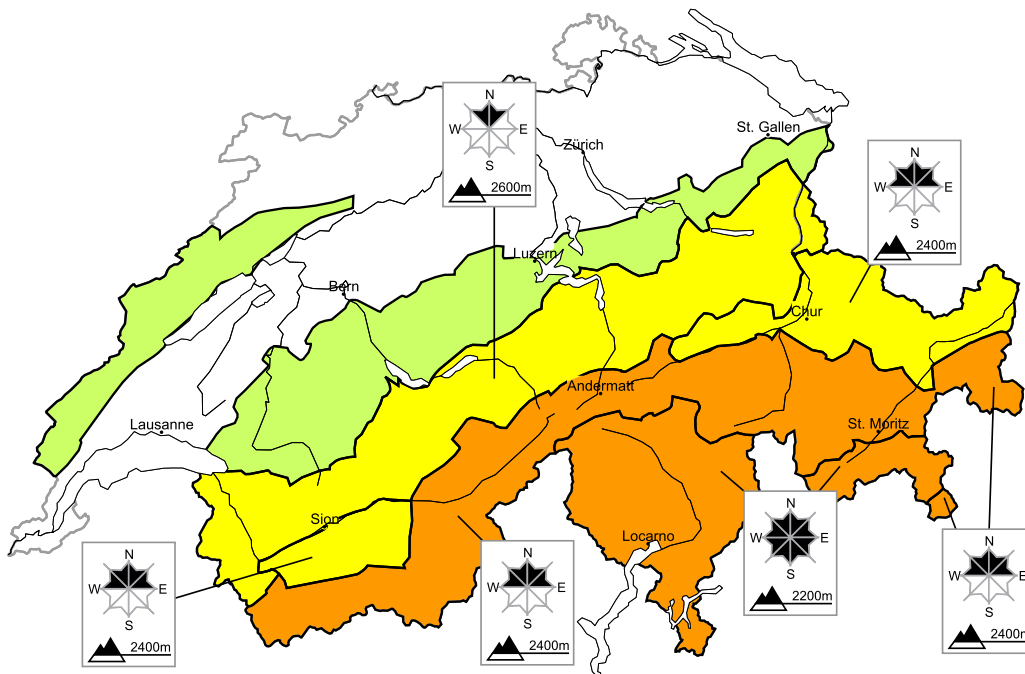


Outside marked and open pistes a considerable avalanche danger will be encountered in some regions

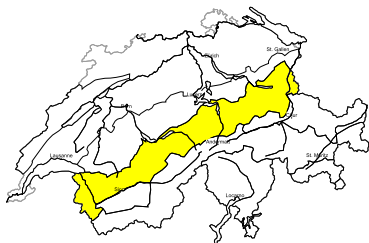

Dry avalanches



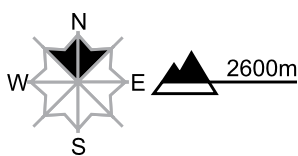
Dry, region C

Danger description

Somewhat older snow drift accumulations have formed in particular at elevated altitudes. These are mostly small but to be assessed with care and prudence. They are to be found in particular in gullies and bowls, and behind abrupt changes in the terrain. Apart from the danger of being buried, restraint should be exercised in particular in view of the danger of avalanches sweeping people along and giving rise to falls.

Additional danger: Wet avalanches as day progresses (see 2nd map)

Danger levels

1 low

2 moderate

3 consider.

4 high

5 very high
