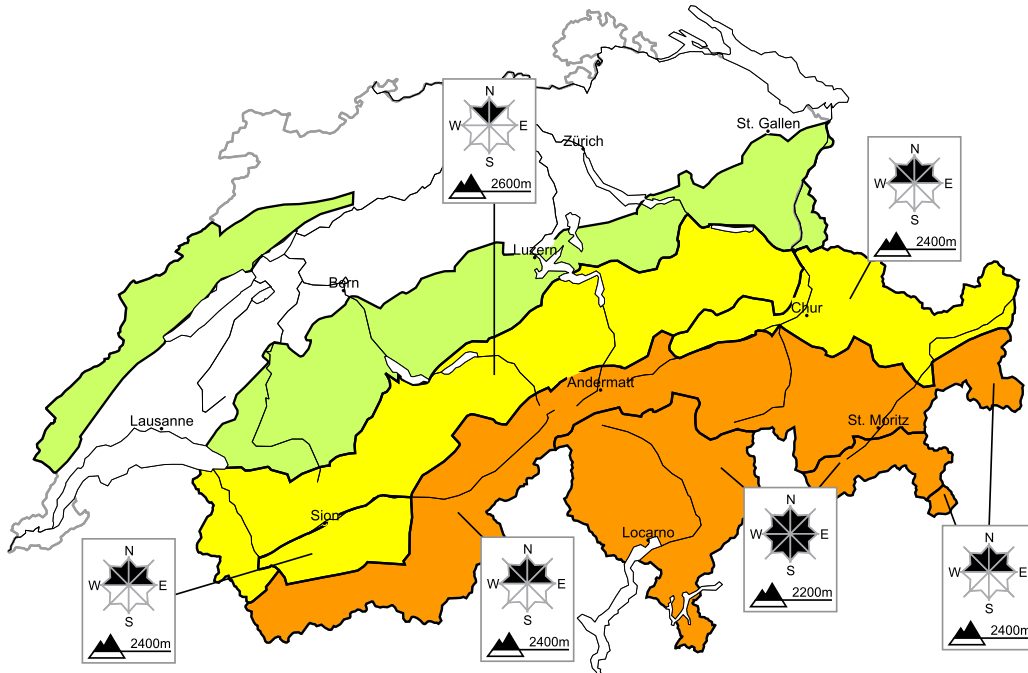


**Outside marked and open pistes a considerable avalanche danger will be encountered in some regions. Wet avalanches as the day progresses**

**Dry avalanches**



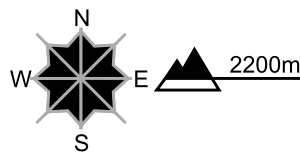
**Dry, region A**

**Danger description**

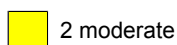
The fresh snow and snow drift accumulations of the last few days can be released by a single winter sport participant. These can in some cases release deeper layers of the snowpack. Avalanches can reach dangerously large size, in particular on steep north facing slopes. Backcountry touring and other off-piste activities call for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger.

**Additional danger: Wet avalanches as day progresses (see 2nd map)**

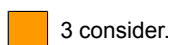

1 low



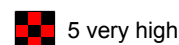
2 moderate
