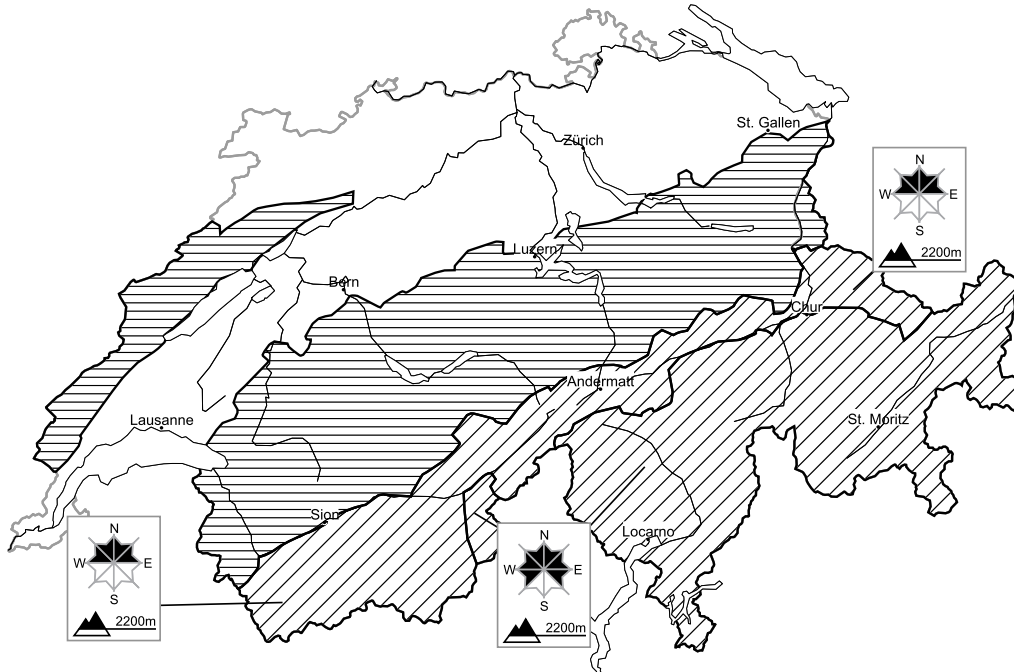

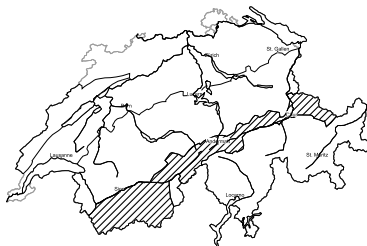

Dry avalanches



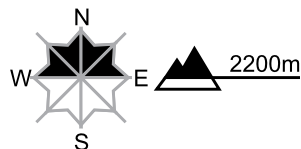
Dry, region B

Danger description

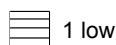
The fresh and somewhat older snow drift accumulations are mostly small but in some cases prone to triggering.

Avalanches can additionally be released in deeper layers in isolated cases. This applies in particular on very steep north facing slopes. Caution is to be exercised in particular in areas where the snow cover is rather shallow. Avalanches can reach medium size in isolated cases.

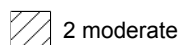
Backcountry touring and other off-piste activities call for careful route selection.

Additional danger: Wet avalanches as day progresses (see 2nd map)

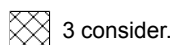

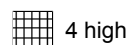

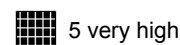
