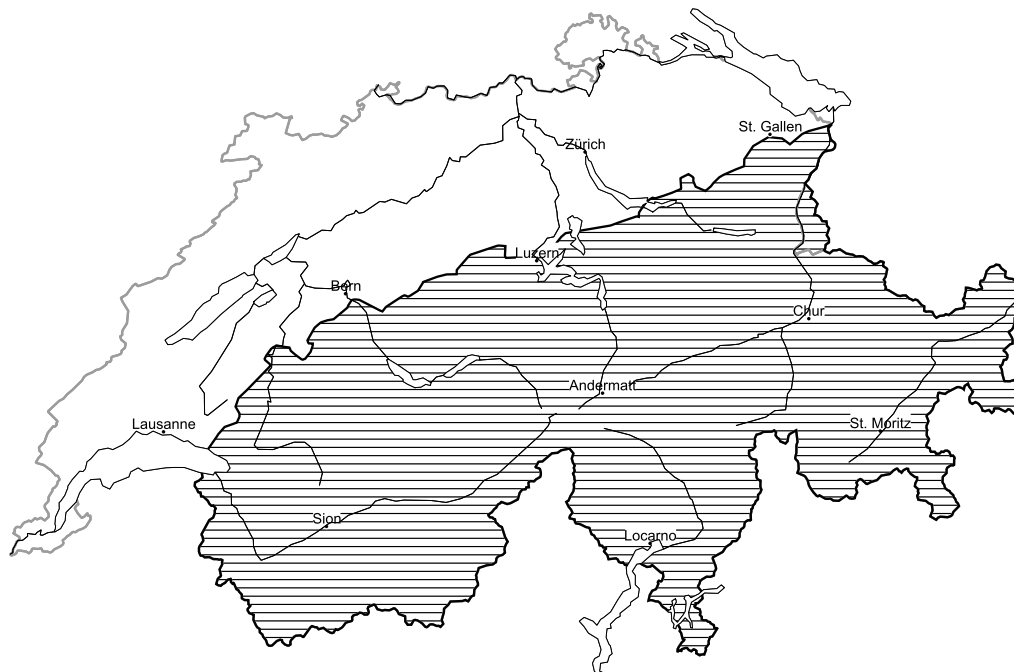


Significant increase in avalanche danger as the day progresses

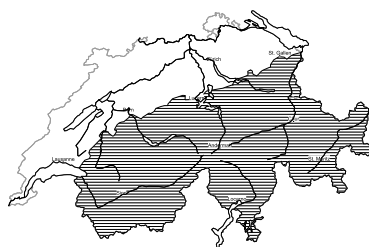

Level 1, low





Individual avalanche prone locations for dry avalanches are to be found on extremely steep north facing slopes, in particular in high Alpine regions. Restraint should be exercised because avalanches can sweep people along and give rise to falls. In the central and eastern parts of the northern flank of the Alps small snow drift accumulations have formed. These are to be evaluated with care and prudence in extreme terrain.
