

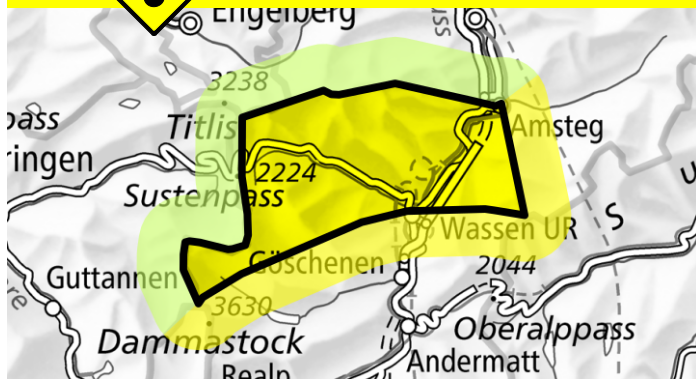

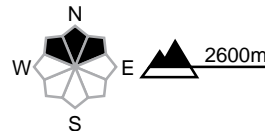
Dry avalanches, whole day

Danger description

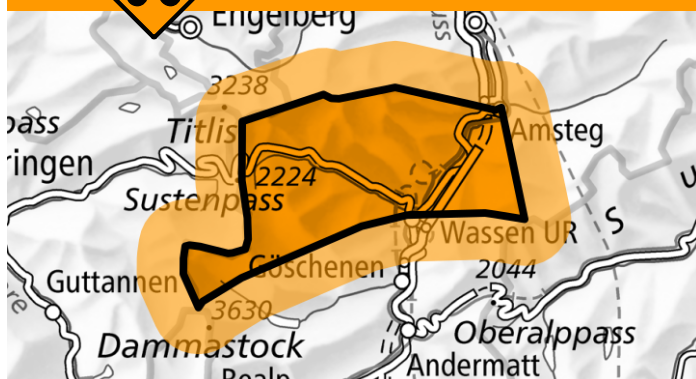
The early morning will see quite favourable avalanche conditions. Dry avalanches can in isolated cases be released in near-surface layers of the snowpack. This applies especially on steep shady slopes. Avalanches can reach medium size.

Meticulous route selection is advisable.



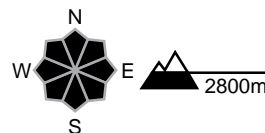
Wet-snow avalanches, as the day progresses

Danger description

As a consequence of warming during the day and solar radiation more frequent moist avalanches are to be expected as the day progresses, even large ones in isolated cases. This applies in particular on sunny slopes below approximately 3000 m, as well as on north facing slopes below approximately 2400 m.

In addition medium-sized and large gliding avalanches are to be expected. This applies in particular on steep grassy slopes.

Backcountry tours, off-piste skiing and ascents to alpine cabins should be started early and concluded timely.

Areas with glide cracks are to be avoided.
