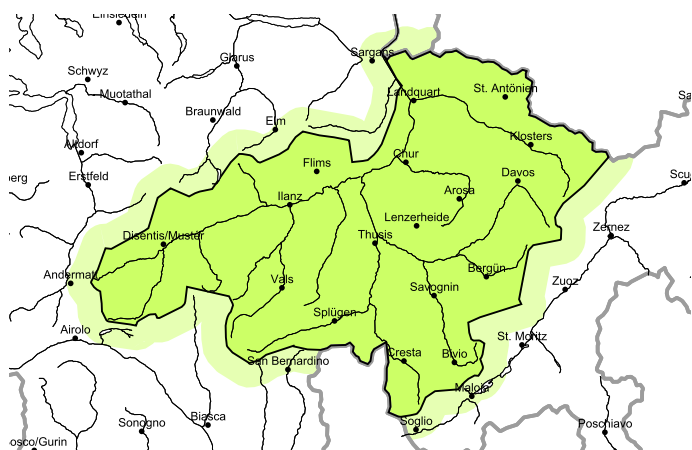


# In the early morning a favourable avalanche situation will prevail. Wet avalanches as the day progresses

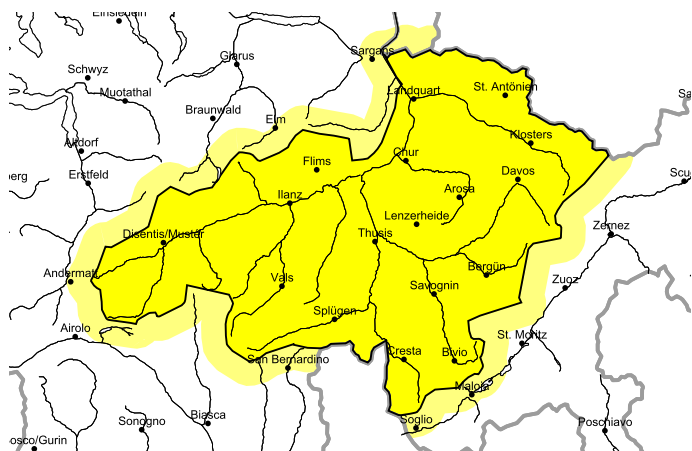
## Dry avalanches



### Level 1, low

Individual avalanche prone locations for dry avalanches are to be found especially on extremely steep north facing slopes above approximately 2200 m. As a consequence of a sometimes moderate southeasterly wind, mostly small wind slabs formed in the last few days in particular in high Alpine regions. Here avalanche prone locations are more prevalent and the danger is slightly greater. Apart from the danger of being buried, restraint should be exercised in particular in view of the danger of avalanches sweeping people along and giving rise to falls.

## Wet avalanches as day progresses



### Level 2, moderate

#### Wet avalanches as day progresses

As a consequence of warming during the day and solar radiation medium-sized and, in isolated cases, large wet and gliding avalanches are to be expected. This applies on very steep south facing slopes below approximately 3000 m as well as on very steep north facing slopes below approximately 2000 m. On very steep east and west facing slopes the avalanche prone locations are to be found below approximately 2700 m. Backcountry tours and off-piste skiing should be started early and concluded timely.
